Tree Care Workshops

A series of Tree Care Training workshops designed to engage, inform, and educate North Georgia homeowners on topics affecting the health and vitality of their trees. Topics are those that frequently elicit uncertainty regarding proper community forest management decisions and their implementation.

Tuesday, July 14th

Proper Tree Pruning:

Reasons for pruning, timing, pruning cuts, structural pruning of young trees, pruning mature trees, techniques, tools, wound dressings, and specialty pruning.

Thursday, July 30th

Tree Hazard Assessment:

Tree hazard inspections, identifying potential hazards; crown structure, faults & defects, decay, decline, and failure. Risk assessment and mitigation. Negligence and liability.

Tuesday, August 25th

Tree Planting and Establishment:

Ten simple steps to planting a tree, aftercare and establishment

Workshops will be taught by and hosted by John Hendrickson, Community Forester and Certified Arborist, with the Rolling Hills Resource Conservation & Development Council and Keith Mickler, University of Georgia Cooperative Extension, Agriculture Agent .
