Contract addendum:

Information regarding Pecan (*Carya illinoensis*) cultivars

In order to insure adequate nut production in pecans, a minimum of two (2) varieties with overlapping pollen production periods should be planted. Additionally, cultivars should show resistance to pecan scab disease and tolerance to late spring freezes that may occasionally occur in north Georgia.

Both type I and type II cultivars should be included in a planting to maximize cross pollination and filled nut production. The varieties listed here have also demonstrated pest resistant and are adapted to our local climate extremes.

Stock type for grafted pecan trees is generally bare root or container grown whips sold by height increment. Either stock type is an appropriate variance from the contract specifications when purchasing and planting pecan trees, although container grown trees generally have higher survival rates.
