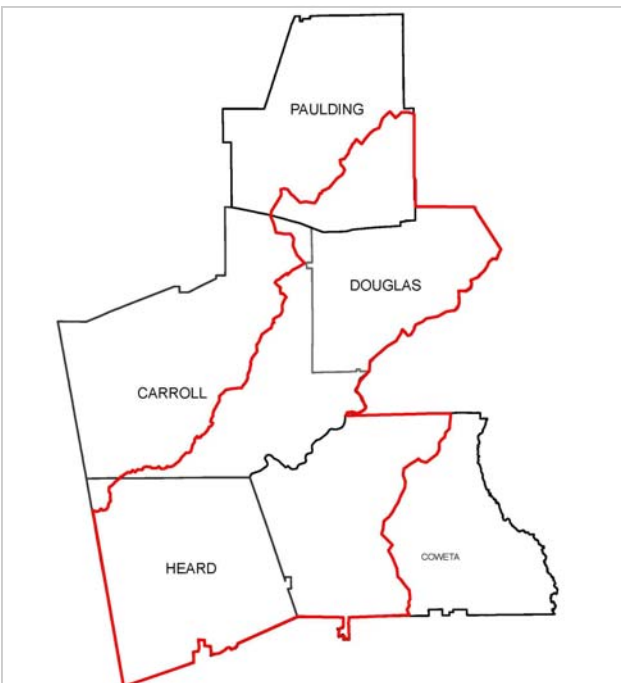


Does this look familiar?

Septic Problems?

You could be eligible for assistance in correcting failing septic tank problems if you live within the Upper Middle Chattahoochee Watershed. Funding will be available through April 2011 for residential landowners to correct potential water quality problems resulting from septic tank failures.

Landowners must live within the watershed boundaries (see map below) to be eligible. There is not a financial requirement to apply.



To participate, landowners must first obtain a septic repair permit from their local Environmental Health offices. All projects will be sent to bid, however landowners will have the option to choose any bidder after the bidding process is complete.
